<p>Granular</p> <p><u>January</u></p> <p>Sign up for Johnson's Do-It-Yourself Lawn Care Program at our Storewide Sale.</p>	<p><u>February</u></p> <p>Apply ferti•lome All Seasons Crabgrass Preventer by mid April — water in.</p>	<p><u>March</u></p> <p>— Crabgrass Preventer.</p> <p>Spray broadleaf weeds with ferti•lome Weed Free Zone.</p> <p>1st mowing - 1½ - 2" to remove dead grass.</p>
<p><u>April</u></p> <p>— Crabgrass Preventer.</p> <p>Seed fescue (<i>best time in September</i>).</p> <p>Mowing height 2 - 2½".</p>	<p><u>May</u></p> <p>Apply ferti•lome Pro Green Lawn Tonic for spring fertilizer.</p>	<p><u>June</u></p> <p>Apply preventative fungus control — for brown patch.</p> <p>Apply preventative grub control — water in.</p> <p>Raise mowing height to 2½ - 3" Water if necessary.</p>
<p><u>July</u></p> <p>2nd application of fungus control.</p> <p>Water 3 times a week (total 1")</p> <p>Use Hi-yield Killzall to kill out bermuda to replant fescue in fall.</p>	<p><u>August</u></p> <p>3rd application of fungus control.</p> <p>Apply 24 Hr. Grub Killer if needed — water in.</p> <p>Continue watering.</p>	<p><u>September</u></p> <p>Apply 1st fall feeding with ferti•lome Winterizer.</p> <p>Aerate compacted soil and apply Natural Guard HuMic Granular.</p> <p>Seed fescue now through Oct.</p>
<p><u>October</u></p> <p>Continue seeding.</p> <p>Control broadleaf weeds mid Oct. through Nov.</p>	<p><u>November</u></p> <p>2nd application of ferti•lome Winterizer.</p> <p>Mow 2 - 2½" — last mowing.</p>	<p><u>December</u></p> <p>Apply 3rd application of ferti•lome Winterizer.</p>

Calendar is approximate, seasonal weather may alter exact timing and watering. Other cool-season grasses, like bluegrass and ryegrass can follow the same schedule, but would need more water and slightly shorter mowing height.
